## DIST. OF COLUMBIA

The National Directory of Mental Health Treatment Facilities is a listing of federal, state, and local government facilities and private facilities that provide mental health treatment services. It includes treatment facilities that responded to the National Substance Use and Mental Health Services Survey (N-SUMHSS). The information about each facility that appears in this Directory was provided by that facility in response to the N-SUMHSS.

The Directory is ordered alphabetically by state, by city within each state, and by facility name within each city. Each facility listing includes codes that represent the services offered and other features of the facility, including codes that indicate services for hearing impaired and non-English-speaking clients. Codes are defined in a key shown at the back of each listing. Because the services offered by a particular facility may change over time, it is always a good idea to verify the information when contacting a facility.
