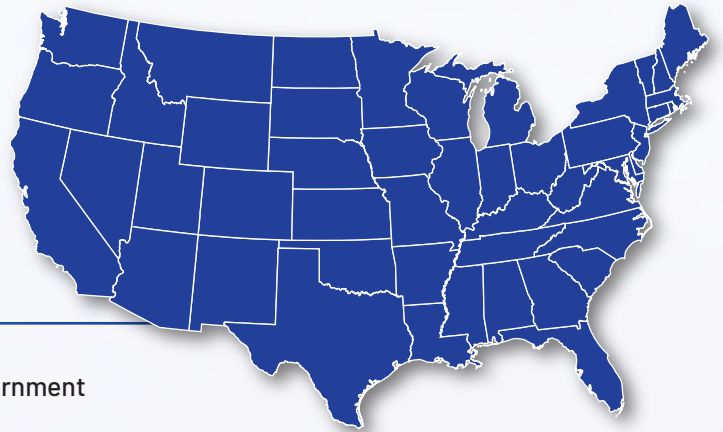

SPRLs are an ideal tool for returning citizens looking to identify sources and repositories of public record documents and those seeking to conduct legal research.

State Public Record Listings Includes 28,000+ Agencies:

- **Agency Facts:** office hour; time zone; web sites, types of records held.
- **Search and Access Facts:** all methods of access; indexing; search requirements; how far back records are kept and available, online availability with comments on accuracy; when public access terminals are onsite; turnaround times.

Criminal Records

Generally juvenile crime information only contains information relative to offenses that would constitute murder or a Class A, Class B or Class C crime if the juvenile is convicted.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1937 on. New records available for inquiry in 1 to 2 days.

Searching: Requests must be in writing. Will only do FBI fingerprint checks as authorized by Maine Statutes. Records are updated as often as records are submitted to this agency. Include in request- name, date of birth, any aliases. Fingerprints are optional. Include maiden name for females. Also include purpose of the inquiry and name and address of requester. 63% of the records are fingerprint-supported. Fingerprints generally are submitted with arrest information to this agency by the police. This data not released: limited juvenile records. All convictions and all pending cases less than 1 year old are reported, or if the case has not yet been adjudicated in court. Per a 2012 U.S. DOJ Study, 81% of all arrests in database have final dispositions recorded.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$31.00 for either a name check or fingerprint check, unless requester has online account, then \$21.00 for a

name check. A notarized document is an additional \$10.00. Fee payee: Treasurer, State of Maine. Prepayment Required. Personal checks accepted. Credit cards accepted at website.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 week.

In person search: This only saves mail-in time; records are returned by mail.

Online search: One may request a record search from the web. Results are usually returned via e-mail in 2 hours. Fee is \$31.00 and use of credit card required unless requester is an in-state subscriber to InforME, then fee is \$21.00 per record. There is a \$95.00 annual fee to be a subscriber.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 01/01/82 to present. New records available for inquiry in 1 to 2 days.

Searching: Include in request- name, date of birth, any aliases (if requesting by mail, phone or fax). Once a request is made and a specific subject is brought up, the requester can ask this agency for more information, including personal information, the description of the offense, dates, and sentence imposed. This data not released: juvenile records, unless convicted as an adult. Also, the entire database is not for sale.

Access by: mail, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no search fee.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1-2 days. A SASE is not required.

Online search: Search at <http://sor.informe.org/cgi-bin/sor/index.pl>. Information is only provided for those individuals that are required to register pursuant to Title 34-A MRSA, Chapter 15. Records date to 01/01/82 and forward. The date of the last address verification is indicated next to the registrant's address.

Indexing & Storage: Records available on current and former inmates. New records available for inquiry in 1 to 2 days.

Searching: Include in request- name, date of birth, any aliases. Fingerprints are optional. This data not released: SSN, current address.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no search fee.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1-2 weeks. A SASE is requested.

Phone search: Name searching available by phone, either through the agency main number or through Victim Services.

Fax search: Records are available by fax.

Online search: There is a free search of current adult prisoners on the web page - see

<https://www.maine.gov/online/mdoc/search-and-deposit/index.htm>. One may also do a search by sending an email to Corrections.Webdesk@maine.gov. Include your full name, address, and reasons for the search. Public information is provided.

Access to trial court records is not available from a central location. All trial court record access must be done at the local level. However, the home page offers a variety of resources and information.

Searching: Note the agency has established the Unified Criminal Docket (UCD), a pilot project designed for a single efficient process for processing criminal actions and certain associated civil violation actions.

Access by: mail, online.

Fee & Payment: There is a \$5.00 handling fee per Supreme Court record ordered by mail.

Mail search: Records of opinions and Supreme Court rulings are available by request.

Online search: The website offers access to Maine Supreme Court opinions and administrative orders, but not all documents are available online. Also, the site offers access to trial court schedules by region and case type. Search probate records free at <https://www.mainejudicial.net/index.html>. Images are \$2.00 each if not registered; \$1.00 each if you subscribe.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1700's on. The older records are in law books. Records on the in-house computer are for all active and some inactive corporations. New records available for inquiry immediately.

Searching: Include in request- full name of business, specific records that you need copies of. In addition to the articles of organization, business entity records available include: Annual Reports (back to 1986), Officers, Directors, Prior (merged) names, Inactive and Reserved names.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: Copies are \$2.00 per page, additional \$5.00 if certified and \$10.00 is specially worded. A Certificate of Existence is \$30.00 and \$10.00 if not for profit. Fee payee: Secretary of State. They will invoice for copies. Personal checks accepted. Visa and MasterCard accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 week. SASE not required.

Phone search: They will provide names and addresses of officers and directors over the phone.

Fax search: Records are available by fax.

In person search: See expedited service.

Online search: A free search of basic information about the entity including address, corporate ID, agent, and status is found at <https://icrs.informe.org/nei-sos-icrs/ICRS>.

A commercial subscriber account also gives extensive information and ability to download files. Also, search securities Division Enforcement Actions and Consent Agreements free at www.maine.gov/pfr/securities/enforcement.shtml.

Other access: Bulk data purchase is available, a list of available databases for sale if found at the web. Monthly lists of new entities filed with this office are also available. Call 207-624-7752 or view

Expedited service: Expedited service is available for mail and phone searches. Turnaround time- 24 hours. Add \$50.00 per business name. For immediate service, the fee is \$100.00 per business name.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1964. Records are computerized since 1993. New records available for inquiry in 3 to 4 days.

Searching: Use search request form UCC-11 when needed for certification. The search includes both federal and state tax liens. Include in request- index number or debtor name only. Try to include a middle initial in your request. They will not search by address or collateral or secured party.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: Paper searches cost \$20.00 per name, certification is an additional \$5.00. An electronic search is \$12.00; also add \$5.00 for certification. Fee payee: Secretary of State Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. VIAS/MC accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: a maximum of 5 days. If update or certain dates requested, state boldly. SASE not required.

In person search: There is one public access terminal. If copies are needed, written request required and fees apply, see expedited services below.

Online search: For search and purchase of official UCC documents and fees visit www.maine.gov/sos/cec/ucconline/index.htm.

Several different searches are offered including an unofficial debtor search for no fee. Find name variations using this unofficial search of debtor name variations of active or lapsed filings (within 1 year past lapsed date). Some fee-based services may require the use of a credit card or subscription with InforME.

Other access: UCC Bulk Database: \$1,200 for all; \$1,500 for-images; \$600 monthly download; \$300 weekly download; \$500 weekly images. Available to subscribers. See www.maine.gov/informe/subscriber/services.htm.

Expedited service: Expedited service is available for mail searches. The Maine specific UCC-11 request form has a box to check if expedited service requested. Add \$10.00 per name for

overnight, \$25.00 if immediate. If by mail, write and highlight the word "Expedite" on the search request.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1993, on computer. However, the MRS has determined that a POA can only go two years into the future. New records available for inquiry in up to 2 months.

Searching: This agency will only confirm to a third party or requester without a power of attorney that a business is registered. Include in request- business name, Entity ID, Acct. Written authorization may be required.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, in person, online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 7 to 10 days. A SASE is helpful. No fee for mail request.

Phone search: No fee for telephone request.

Fax search: Same criteria as mail searching.

In person search: No fee for request. Proper ID required.

Online search: Maine Revenue Service provides an online Sales and Service Provider Tax Lookup Program. This program can be used to determine whether a customer's Resale Certificate or Sales Tax Exemption Certificate is currently valid. See <https://portal.maine.gov/certlookup/>.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1923 to present. Maine State Archives has records prior to 1923 (call 207-287-5795). Records are indexed on computer from 1975 to present, and on microfiche from 1892 to present. New records available for inquiry in up to one month.

Searching: Must give relationship to person of record and reason for request. Confidential information will not be released except to the person listed on the birth certificate. Include in request- full name, names of parents, mother's maiden name, date of birth, place of birth and copy of your photo ID (written requests). Application for a search and certified copy of a Vital Record found at www.maine.gov/dhhs/mecdc/public-health-systems/data-research/vital-records/documents/pdf-files/vrform2.pdf. This data not released: illegitimate births or adoption records.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: \$15.00 fee for certified copy, \$10.00 for uncertified, add \$6.00 per name for additional copy of same record. Fee payee: Treasurer, State of Maine. Prepayment required.

Personal checks accepted. Visa, M/C, AMEX and Discover credit cards accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 2 weeks. Specific dates are needed to search as well as names (if available). SASE requested.

In person search: Turnaround time is while you wait.

Online search: Records may be ordered online via www.vitalchek.com, a designated vendor.

Other access: Physical birth lists are available for purchase, excluding restricted information.

Expedited service: Turnaround time- 1-5 days. Use of credit card is required. Add fee of \$29.95 for 1-3 days service or \$22.95 for 45 days service or \$12.95 for 7-10 day service.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1923 to present. Maine State Archives has records prior to 1923 (call 207-287-5795). Records are indexed on computer from 1975 to present, and on microfiche from 1892 to present. New records available for inquiry in up to 1 month.

Searching: Access to cause of death is restricted to those with a legitimate interest in the information. All information on certificate of death is confidential, except name, age, date of death, as well as city/town where death occurred. Include in request- full name, date of death, place of death, relationship to person of record. Application for a search and certified copy of a Vital Record found at www.maine.gov/dhhs/mecdc/public-health-systems/data-research/vital-records/documents/pdf-files/vrform2.pdf. This data not released: cause of death, unless a direct and legitimate interest.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: \$15.00 fee for certified copy, \$10.00 for uncertified, add \$6.00 per name for additional copy of same record. Fee payee: Treasurer, State of Maine. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Visa and MasterCard accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 2 weeks. When requesting a search, keep in mind that records are filed by the date of the death, and then by name. SASE required.

Phone search: See expedited service.

In person search: Turnaround time is while you wait.

Online search: Search death records for 1960 thru 12/31/2009 at https://portal.maine.gov/death/archdev.death_archive_search_form. Also, a free genealogy site at <http://vitals.rootsweb.ancestry.com/me/death/search.cgi> has Death Indexes from 1960-1997. Search by surname, given name, place or year.

Other access: Bulk file purchases are available, with the exclusion of restricted data.

Expedited service: Expedited service is available for mail, phone and fax searches. Turnaround time- 1-5 days. Use of credit card is required. Add fee of \$29.95 for 1-3 days service or \$22.95 for 4-5 days service or \$12.95 for 7-10 day service.

Searching: Must give relationship to persons of record and reason for request. Data recorded in the section of the certificate specified as confidential is not released (i.e. race, education, etc.). Include in request- names of husband and wife, date of marriage, place or county of marriage. Application for a search and certified copy of a Vital Record found at www.maine.gov/dhhs/mecdc/public-health-systems/data-research/vital-records/documents/pdf-files/vrform2.pdf.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: \$15.00 fee for certified copy, \$10.00 for uncertified, add \$6.00 per name for additional copy of same record. Fee payee: Treasurer, State of Maine. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Visa and MasterCard accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 2 weeks. SASE requested.

Phone search: See expedited service.

In person search: Turnaround time is while you wait.

Online search: Records from 1892 thru 2009 at https://portal.maine.gov/marriage/archdev.marriage_archive_search_form.

Other access: Bulk file purchasing is available, with restricted data excluded.

Expedited service: Expedited service is available for mail, phone and fax searches. Turnaround time- 1-5 days. Use of credit card is required. Add fee of \$29.95 for 1-3 days service or \$22.95 for 4-5 days service or \$12.95 for 7-10 day service.

Searching: Must give relationship to persons of record and reason for request. Include in request- names of husband and wife, date of divorce, place of divorce. Most case files created prior to 1999 were maintained in paper format only. Since 2006, all cases are filed electronically. Details on the Trial Court Structure

A **Superior Court** is located in each of Maine's sixteen counties, except for Aroostook County which has two Superior Courts. A Superior Court may hear almost any kind of civil or criminal case that may be brought to trial. Criminal offenses are divided by the Maine Criminal Code into classes according to the seriousness of the offense and the penalty. Classes A, B and C are the more serious offenses; Classes D and E, the least. The Superior Court hears Class D and E cases if there is a jury; otherwise the case is heard by the **District Court**. Thus both the Superior and District Courts handle misdemeanor and felony cases, with jury trials being held in Superior Court only.

The Legislature created a special class of civil actions that includes offenses not regarded as serious enough to be dealt with as crimes. These less serious offenses are called **civil violations**. They include minor traffic infractions, possession of a small amount of marijuana, and violations of town and city called ordinances. One may be fined, but not imprisoned, for a civil violation.

As stated, the **District Court** hears both civil and criminal and always sits without a jury. Within the District Court is the **Family Division**, which hears all divorce and family matters including those involving children, child support and paternity cases. The District Court also hears child protection cases, and serves as the Juvenile Court. Actions for protection from abuse or harassment, mental health, small claims cases (\$6,000 limit), and money judgments are filed in the District Court. All traffic violation hearings take place in the District Court in the Division in which the infraction is alleged to have been committed. The traffic violations are then processed the centralized Violations Bureau, part of the District Court system. Prior to year 2001, District Courts accepted civil cases involving claims less than \$30,000. Now, District Courts have jurisdiction concurrent with that of the Superior Court for all civil actions, except cases vested in the Superior Court by statute.

The **Business and Consumer Court**, also known as the BCD, is a statewide docket comprised of selected actions involving business and /or consumer disputes,

Probate Courts are part of the county's court system, not the state system. Although the Probate Court may be housed with other state courts, the court is generally on a different phone system and calls may not be transferred.

Fees and Record Searching Tips

Per Administrative Order Maine Superior and District Court search fees are as follows: 1) \$20.00 per name for a search, fee charged for each alias submitted; 2) copy fee: 1st page is \$2.00, \$1.00 each additional; 3) if a mail request does not include a self-addressed stamped envelope, then add an additional \$5.00. NEW NAME SEARCH PROCEDURES:

In 2015, the Maine Judicial Branch implemented a new procedure for all civil and criminal name search requests. The Judicial Branch Service Center, in Lewiston, Maine is the central location for all record search requests for all District and Superior Courts in the State of Maine and the Violations Bureau. All walk-in and mail search requests made at the local individual courts are no longer honored. One must have the case number in order to obtain documents in person

The new system requires that all requests must be submitted on the agency's *Request for Records Search* Form. The fee is \$20.00 per name per location; however, the fee includes a search of both the criminal and civil docket index if requested. The agency hopes to provide a turnaround time of 1 to 2 days; however, as of early 2015 the turnaround time is as much as 2 weeks.

Maine Recording Offices

Organization: The recording officer is the County Register of Deeds. There are 16 counties and 18 recording offices (registry districts). Aroostook and Oxford Counties each have 2 recording offices.

Property assessors are at the town or city level, not at the county level. There are at least 440 towns and cities in Maine. Only the Assessor associated with the county seat is shown herein.

Maine is in the Eastern Time Zone (EST).

Types of Documents Recorded

Available at the Registry are any documents pertaining to real estate such as deeds, mortgages, assignments, partial releases, liens and discharges. Other documents that may be recorded include abstracts of wills, abstracts of divorces, leases, attachments and foreclosures, bills of sale, affidavits and agreements.

All tax liens on real estate are filed with the Register of Deeds, otherwise they are filed with the Secretary of State.

Searching Recorded Documents:

Agencies will not perform real estate name searches, but some will lookup a name informally. Copy fee in most counties is \$1.00 per page. Certification fees vary widely. Assessor and tax records are located at the town/city level.

Searching Tax Lien and UCC Records:

All tax liens on real estate are filed with the Register of Deeds, otherwise they are filed with the Secretary of State.

UCC Financing statements on fixtures, timber to be cut, or extracted minerals are filed at the appropriate County Registry of Deeds. Counties do not perform UCC searches. Copy fee is usually \$1.00 per page.

Maine County Locator

You will usually be able to find the city name in the City/County Cross Reference below. In that case, it is a simple matter to determine the county from the cross reference. However, only the official US Postal Service city names are included in this index. There are an additional 40,000 place names that people use in their addresses. Therefore, we have also included a ZIP/City Cross Reference immediately following the City/County Cross Reference.

If you know the ZIP Code but the city name does not appear in the City/County Cross Reference index, look up the ZIP Code in the ZIP/City Cross Reference, find the city name, then look up the city name in the City/County Cross Reference. For example, you want to know the county for an address of Menands, NY 12204. There is no "Menands" in the City/County Cross Reference.
